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## First Aid Level 1

First Aid Level 1 Training is for persons required to assess the emergency situation and providing basic Life Support and basic First Aid in order to stabilise patients prior to the arrival of Emergency Services. People that have undergone First Aid Level 1 Training will be able to: demonstrate an understanding of emergency scene management, demonstrate an understanding of elementary anatomy and physiology, assess an emergency situation, apply First Aid procedures to a life-threatening situation and treat common injuries.

Drum Beat Academy offers a SETA-accredited First Aid Level 1 course. It is important to remember that all qualified tourist guides that want to register need to have a valid First Aid Level 1 qualification. This course is presented on a monthly basis at our head office in Pretoria but can be scheduled in other areas if the demand is big enough.

### Course Content:

- Emergency scene management
- Anatomy & physiology
- Emergency situations & common injuries
- First aid procedures

### Entrance requirements:

- Learner should have a basic comprehension of English
- Basic reading, writing and mathematical skills are required

### Duration:

2 days (Starting at 08:00 to 16:00 on both days, lunch is not provided)

### Assessment:

- Completion of workbook
- Practical demonstration of first aid skills

### Award:

Drum Beat Academy Certificate (underwritten by HW-SETA and Dep. Labour)

## First Aid Level 2

First Aid Level 2 training will be useful for employees to enable them to provide Primary Emergency Care (First Aid) in response to an occupational risk induced or any health emergency in their specific workplaces.

People that have undergone First Aid Level 2 training will be able to demonstrate the principles of primary emergency care, assess and control a single injury emergency scene in the workplace, demonstrate primary emergency life support for adults, children and infants, explain and manage shock, carry out secondary assessment of the sick or injured person and provide appropriate primary emergency care at the scene, keep records of the incident/accident.

## First Aid Level 3

First Aid Level 3 training is for persons who are responsible to apply First Aid in a work place. The training requires learners to be able to demonstrate the interpretation of vital signs when providing Primary Emergency Care (First Aid). The purpose of the learning is to enable the first responder in the workplace to prevent and respond to health emergencies at an advanced level.

People that have undergone First Aid Level 3 training will be able to describe first aid equipment and explain basic application, assess the accident scene, report and make safe, prioritise the casualties and treat, identifying the anatomical position for taking of vital signs of the human body, monitoring of vital signs is demonstrated, interpreting and recording of vital signs, demonstrate the principles of advanced primary emergency care in all health emergencies for people in the workplace, sustain advanced level of preparedness to deal with emergencies in the workplace, assess and manage a multiple injured emergency scene/disaster in the workplace, demonstrate knowledge and understanding of anatomy and physiology of the human body and the specific disorders and diseases relating to each system, demonstrate primary emergency life support for adults in the workplace, explain and manage shock, conduct secondary assessment of the sick or injured person(s) and maintain appropriate primary emergency care.

## Basic Fire Awareness (1 Day)

Basic Fire Awareness training enables learners to understand the procedures of dealing with fires in the work place.

When the Basic Fire Awareness training has been completed the learner will be able to identify types of fires, identify causes of fires, select appropriate fire fighting procedures, correctly check and use firefighting equipment, practically contain and extinguish fires, correct reporting of status of fire and equipment.

## Terms and Conditions:
